In celebration of this wonderful summer festival, Chris Hannah, bar manager at French 75 Bar in the French Quarter, created this vibrant, refreshing cocktail that's as complex and unique as the man for whom it is named. ♣

- 1 1/2 ounces gin
- 1/2 ounce Crème Yvette liqueur
- 1/2 ounce lime juice
- 1/2 ounce Crème de Mur liqueur
- 2 ounces Reed's ginger beer or to taste
- blackberries for garnish
- dash of Angostura bitters

Add all ingredients except ginger beer and bitters to a cocktail shaker. Shake vigorously and strain into an ice-filled highball glass. Top with Reed's ginger beer and garnish with blackberries and a dash of bitters.
